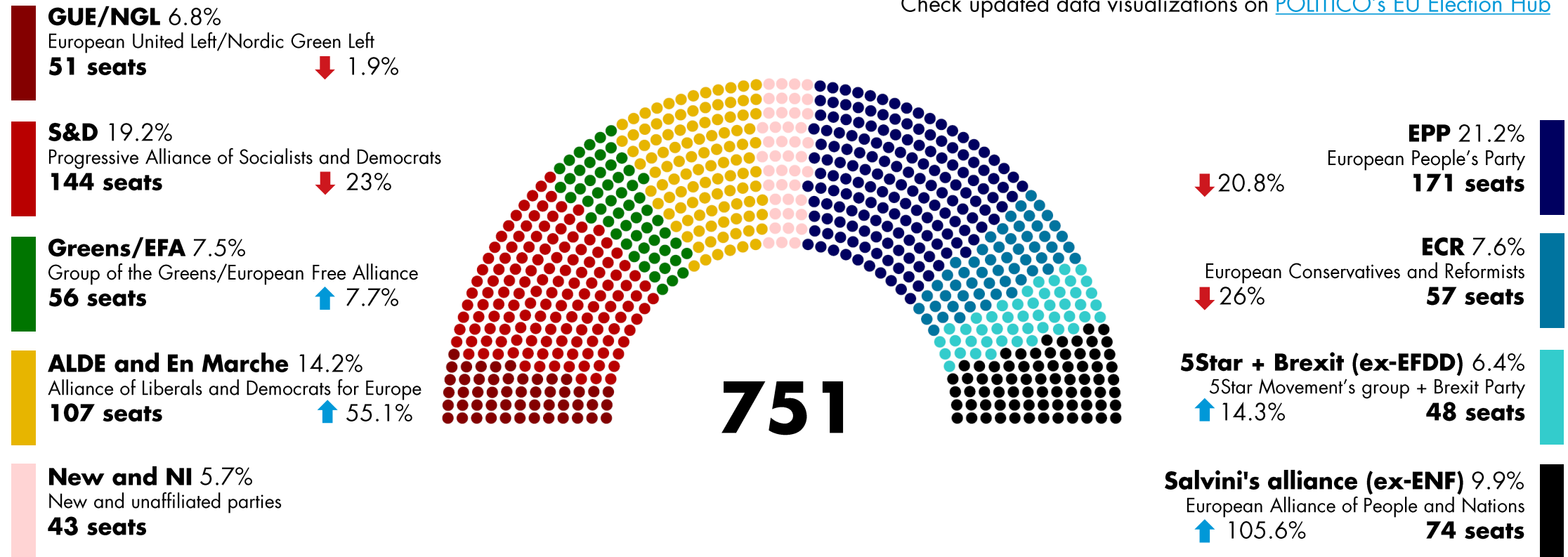


EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT ELECTION 2019: MAY 22 PROJECTION

The projection for the composition of the next Parliament is based on an aggregation of national polls. The forecasts show the two biggest groups — the EPP and S&D — are likely to lose their majority. Italian leader Matteo Salvini’s Euroskeptical alliance and the liberal ALDE are projected to see the biggest increase in their number of seats.

NOTE: Numbers next to the arrows indicate projected percentage change in the number of seats won by a group from the outgoing Parliament. The U.K. has announced it will take part in the European election (so the total number of seats will remain at 751), but if a Brexit deal is agreed in time, British MEPs may not take their seats in the new Parliament. Percentages may not add up to 100 due to rounding.
